





Fairtrade Policy

Kirkwall Grammar School is committed to supporting Fairtrade wherever possible. In particular we will:

- Ensure Fairtrade is part of the School Improvement Plan.
- Use Fairtrade products/ingredients where possible:
 - For cooking activities
 - Tea, coffee and sugar in the staff room and meetings.
 - In the dinning hall and tuck-shop.
- Ask the Local Authority to include the use of Fairtrade products as a requirement in catering contracts for schools.
- Ensure Fairtrade is taught as part of appropriate subjects.
- Explore the possibility of school uniform being made from Fairtrade materials.
- Explore the possibility of Fairtrade certified sports balls for the PE Department
- Promote Fairtrade within the school and local community, particularly during Fair Trade Fortnight.
