With the timetable changing after Activities we would like to remind everyone at KGS about Dress Code expectations.

**WHY?**

We wear Dress Code at KGS to:

- Promote a pride and sense of belonging to our school
- Create a positive impression for anyone meeting our pupils
- Improve school security by making it easier to identify intruders
- Promote a sense of equality among pupils
- Encourage a state of mind in pupils where you are able to focus on learning and personal development
- Prepare our pupils for the world of work where smart or professional levels of dress are expected and dress codes/uniforms are common

**WHAT IS THE DRESS CODE?**

Dress Code is required to be worn at all times when you are in school. This includes ALL CLASSROOMS and ALL SOCIAL AREAS.

- Hoodie, Sweatshirt, Polo Shirt or T-shirt that displays the school logo should be worn at all times
- School tops SHOULD NOT be worn under other clothing and should be seen at all times
- Pupils may wear a white, black or navy shirt and school tie
- Plain dark trousers/jeans or skirts
- No shorts, patterns, stripes or bright colours
