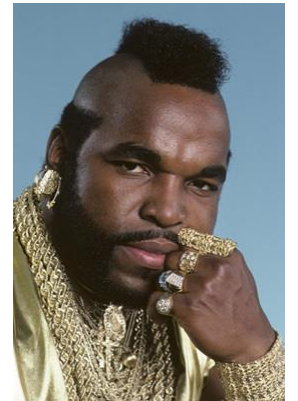

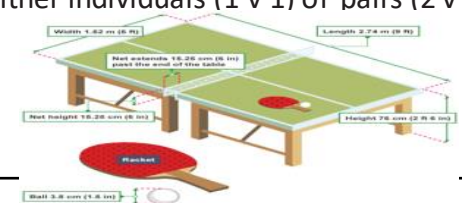

But just whisper the word "Jollof" in West Africa and you could easily start a fiery feud of passion. That's because determining which West African nation makes Jollof best is an ongoing matter of local pride and contention.</p> <p>Jollof rice is to West Africa what paella is to Spain, risotto to Italy, biriyani to India and fried rice to China. As a child growing up in Nigeria, I gobbled Jollof down at family gatherings, birthdays, coming-of-age ceremonies, engagement parties and weddings.</p> <p>Enjoyed as a main meal, this rich, mouth-watering dish consists of rice cooked in a flavourful sauce of tomatoes, onions and aromatic spices. These base ingredients are often layered with ginger, garlic, thyme, tomato puree, curry powder and Scotch bonnet chillies (though the exact components and preparation differ from country to country; even from house to house). While each plate of Jollof may vary, everyone brings exciting flavours. The savoury sweetness of onions is very important. Seasoning is crucial.
