

Abolitionists



William Wilberforce

Wilberforce was an MP wh campaigned for 20 years against the slave trade.

He regularly gave speeche and proposed anti-slavery laws in Parliament.

Thomas Clarkson

Thomas Clarkson was an English anti-slavery campaigner and a Quaker.

He helped found the campaign group 'The Society for Affecting the Abolition of the Slave Trade'.





Olaudah Equiano

Equiano was a former slave

He managed to buy his freedom and then set up a anti-slavery group.


He also wrote books and spoke at public meetings.

John Newton

Newton was a former slave ship captain.

He wrote a book about the evils of the slave trade and spoke at public meetings.

Hannah More


More was a teacher who became a writer.
